purpose: Resamples, with replacement, from a dataset.

If the data is a matrix with more than one column and row, the resamples are drawn row by row.

If n is not given, the number of samples will be the number of data points in data. (If data is a matrix, this is the number of rows. If data is a vector, this is length(data)).
